Tasks

- Manage and organise the team on match days
- Sorting out umpiring/scoring for the match
- Liaising with coaches to pick a team for the match
- Act as a role model for the young cricketers, instilling sporting values to their game

- Matches will be as local as possible likely to be
- Matches to be arranged for either weekday evenings or weekend mornings
