# **The Performance Pathway**

The Performance Pathway is Devon Cricket's elite talent development programme. The Performance Pathway is designed to develop the potential of Devon's finest young cricketers with the aim of progressing to elite senior cricket.

The diagram on *Page 3* illustrates the progression route through the Performance Pathway.

The below table explains the different levels within the Performance Pathway in ascending order. Existing age groups at each level are highlighted in bold. These are correct as of the 2023 season.

## **Youth Development Cricket**

#### **YDC**

Youth Development Cricket provides a level of cricket between Club and County Age Group Cricket, and aims to identify talented players within a structured environment.

#### CAG

County Age Group Cricket is the second level within the Performance Pathway, and aims to further develop talented players identified within the pathway.

# **Pathway Philosophy**

The primary aim of the Performance Pathway is to IDENTIFY, DEVELOP and INSPIRE high-potential young cricketers across Devon.



- > To encourage enjoyment, participation and gaining awareness of the different facets of the game.
- > Players to stay in their own YDC or CAG age groups, unless specific role opportunities dictate otherwise.
- > Players to be given as equal an opportunity as possible in a season. Rotation of players offering different match scenario roles will be the norm.
- > Aim to play various formats of cricket.
- > Aiding the transition of players along the Devon Cricket Performance Pathway in a smooth and transparent manner.



- > Begin the process of identifying (where appropriate) high potential and high performance players in the YDC and CAG squads.
- Continue to provide as equal an opportunity as possible, for all YDC and CAG players through an adequate quantity of YDC and CAG training sessions and matches.
- > Continue to offer variation of roles in a team in the summer season. Begin to identify individuals for certain roles. Players to stay in their own age groups, unless specific opportunities dictate otherwise.
- > Aim to play various formats of cricket, including multi-day.
- Aiding the transition of players along the Devon Cricket Performance Pathway in a smooth and transparent manner.

#### **U16s - U18s**

#### ENJOYMENT | AWARENESS | DEVELOPMENT | DEMONSTRATE

- > Designed for players that have genuine potential or to perform to a high level in a competitive environment.
- > Enable players (who may end up developing later) to stay in the system for longer.
- > Encourages players to play the highest level of competitive cricket available to them.
- > Begin to identify and execute primary roles within an age group and varying formats of cricket.
- > Aim to play various formats of cricket, including multi-day.
- > Aiding the transition of players along the Devon Cricket Performance Pathway and beyond in a smooth and transparent manner.

#### **18s and over**

# ENJOYMENT | AWARENESS | DEVELOPMENT DEMONSTRATE | EVIDENCE

- > For players that have genuine potential or to perform to a high level in a competitive environment.
- > Enable players (who may end up developing later) to stay in the system for longer.
- > Encourages players to play the highest level of competitive cricket available to them.
- > Begin to identify and execute primary roles within varying formats of cricket.
- > Aim to play various formats of cricket, including multi-day.
- Aiding the transition of players beyond the Devon Cricket Performance Pathway in a smooth and transparent manner.

# **Coaches' Judgement**

**Coaches' judgement consists of many things, including:** 

# OPINION | KNOWLEDGE | EXPERIENCE EVIDENCE | STATS

- > Observation of the player over a period of time.
- > A coach's experience, using previous knowledge of Pathway Players.
- > Whether a coach believes a player has the potential, skill and mindset to perform in Pathway Cricket.

#### **INSTINCT**

> A coach may see a snapshot, something the player does in a moment that the coach believes may be a sign they have the potential to be a Pathway Cricketer.





## **Other Considerations**



#### **ATTRIBUTES**

- Tactical, Technical, Mental and Physical.\*
- > Genetics.



#### **RELATIVE AGE EFFECT**

 What month a player is born in and its effect on development compared to their peers.



#### **GROWTH MINDSET**

- The ability to respond to tough situations, challenge and adversity in a positive manner.
- > A willingness to grow as a player and a person.



#### **THRESHOLD & DIFFERENTIATORS**

- Pathway Coaches' opinion on the ceiling of a player's potential ability.
- The outstanding attributes a player possesses that differentiates them from their peers.



#### **LEVEL OF MATURATION**

- The biological maturity of a player and its effect on performance compared to their peers.
- > A player's Peak Height Velocity.



#### **FAST ADAPTERS**

 A player's ability to adapt quickly to changes in circumstance or situation.<sup>†</sup>

## **Other Considerations**



#### **COACHABILITY**

> The willingness for a player to take advice and implement suggestions to improve their game.



#### **EXPOSURE TO CRICKET**

 The level of expoure a player has had outside the Performance Pathway compared to their peers.



#### **COPING UNDER PRESSURE**

> Whether the player can perform and deliver when they are under pressure.



#### **OTHERS' INPUT**

 Using other experts to help formulate a view on players.



#### **CHARACTER**

- When selecting players, character traits will also be considered. Examples of desirable character traits include, but not limited to:
  - Motivation
  - **⋄** Self-discipline
  - ♦ Resilience
  - **⋄** Tenacity
  - Clarity of thought
  - Acceptance of criticism

- **♦** Humility
- ♦ Respect
- ♦ Passion
- ♦ Punctual
- **⋄** Supportive
- **⋄** Competitiveness



#### **PERFORMANCE STATISTICS**

- > Player statistics will form part of selection.
- > The younger the player, the less statistics will be used as a selection tool.
- > The older the player, the greater the significance of statistics and performance.

The coaches engaged in the selection of squads and teams will work through the considerations above and use them as their definitive guide to shape their choices of players.

Squads and teams are not selected by individuals but by groups of coaches and the decisions made are underpinned by many and lengthy discussions between them.

Coaches have the overarching responsibility for their team and, as such, their decisions are – and have to be – final in terms of selection.

# Player Responsibilities and Expectations

#### **COMMITMENT TO DEVON CRICKET**

- > An expectation for players to attend a high percentage of training sessions and fixtures, and to prioritise Pathway cricket above lower level activities.
- > Pride to represent the County, i.e.: wearing Devon branded training and playing kit.
- > Commitment to better oneself, as a cricketer, both within and away from Pathway programmes.

#### **OUTSTANDING COMMUNICATION**

> Providing Devon Cricket coaches/officials with early, accurate and ongoing correspondence throughout the yearly cycle.
